- Sofas, chairs and recliners (if slept on) should be stripped.
- Mattresses and box springs should be discarded if heavily infested. They should then be wrapped and sealed in plastic to be removed from the apartment and building.
- If the mattresses or box springs are not heavily infested then they will be treated and then you **MUST** enclose both mattresses and box springs in plastic covers purchased from your local merchants.
- Remove all bedding and linens and wash in the hottest water possible.
- Empty dresser drawers and closets. Wash clothing in the hottest water possible and place in a plastic bag until treatment is rendered.
- Pull furniture and all other items away from walls.
- Remove electrical switch plates and outlet covers.
- Dismantle bed frames and stand mattresses and box springs on end if not discarded.
- Customer should remove the cotton cover on the underside of the box spring to expose internal springs.
- Inspect recently used luggage and travel bags for bedbugs.
- It may be necessary for the customer to discard any electrical items near the infested areas such as alarm clocks, phones, stereos, etc.
- All furniture should be wiped down from top to bottom with a cloth, getting in all the cracks and crevices.
- All windows, windowsills and window frames should be wiped down.
- Any pictures on the wall should be taken down and wiped down on the front and back. Also, wipe down the wall where the picture was hung.
- Lastly, vacuum the floor areas whether it's wood, carpet, etc., several times and then discard vacuum bag outside and clean inside the vacuum and underneath the wheels so as not to bring anything back in.

Please remember that all occupants must remain out of treated areas for approximately four (4) hours after treatment is completed or until all treated surfaces are dry. Bedbugs can be difficult to eliminate and a second treatment might

be necessary. It may also be necessary for us to drill and dust wall voids in certain situations.

Bedbugs can be introduced into structures through many different avenues. New mattresses and/or furniture can be the cause. Also, they may be introduced through luggage and travel bags from a recent trip. Bedbugs are nocturnal insects and are primarily active only at night. They hide in tiny cracks and crevices and come out to feed. Our treatment is to target the hiding areas and treat them appropriately. The more we have access to, the greater the chance we have of eliminating them quickly.
